SCHOOL POLICY GUIDELINES 2025-2026

Behavior policy

Applicability:

This policy applies to the conduct of students which directly or indirectly disrupts the learning environments within the class/school, or during online learning and calls. Any kind of cyber bullying towards their classmates or teachers.

Policy statement

:

We aim to embed, within its students, a strong shared feeling of responsibility towards their learning while upholding concrete concepts of respect for oneself and other around them.

Rights and responsibilities:

Students will be responsible to make sure that they:

- 1. Follow proper code of conduct within the school's premises and outside.
- 2. Do not engage in any unacceptable behavior.
- 3. Do not use devices in an inappropriate way.
- 4. Arrive to class on time to show respect to the teachers and their classmates.
- 5. Do not disturb by making any sound or banging during class.
- 6. When called by the teacher, the student should answer and not keep their mic shut or ignore.
- 7. It is mandatory during exams for students to turn their cameras off during invigilation.

Procedures:

Teacher will imminently report major infractions to supervisors/social workers while documenting the minor infractions. The staff member will avoid any actions with the students who breach any policy.

Behavior Policy following up procedures

Level 1 infractions:

- 1. Not bringing books or resources.
- 2. Late or being absent to classes.
- 3. Not turning on their mics.

- 1. Bringing phones/taking photos.
- 2. Cheating.
- 3. Makeup/inappropriate behavior.

- 1. Offending political and religious symbols.
- 2. Sexual or physical abuse.
- 3. Offending any religion
- 4. Taking or selling any kind of drugs.
- 5. Bringing up extremes and takfiri ideas.

Primary student	Student will be prohibited from studying in the school this year but can continue to study in the school next year Parent notice to be sent.				
Secondary student	The student will be suspended but will be given a chance to register in another school

Emergency meeting procedures:

$\it 1$ - Supervisor caries out the initial investigations and informs disciplinary action board chairman of the incident.
2- The disciplinary action board chairman informs members of the board for an emergency meeting
$\it 3$ - The disciplinary action board meets and decides an action plan
4- The parents are contacted on the same day and subsequent actions take place.
